Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

• We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting

Q1: Annual tonnage data broken down by the following waste streams:

- Waste for incineration 305.959t
- Alternative treatment 866.338t
- Offensive waste 173.852t

Q2. Contract start date

The contract started over 10 years ago.

Q3. Contract term including any extensions

Contract is ending at the end of March 2022 with possible extensions being discussed.

Q4. Annual contract value; overall and split by Waste Stream.

We have considered whether it would be in the public interest for us to provide you with the requested information, despite the exemption being applicable. In this case, we have concluded that the public interest favours withholding the information. We reached the view that, on balance, the public interest is better served by withholding this information under Sections 43 of the Freedom of Information Act at this time. Section 43 of the FOI Act provides that information is exempt if its disclosure would, or would be likely to prejudice the commercial interests of any person. Therefore we are withholding this information at this time.
