Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting
- 1. Which supplier currently provides your surgical instrument decontamination chemicals for the Trust?

- 2. With regards to surgical instrument decontamination in the Trust's Sterile Service Department (s), what percentage of instruments require rewashing? 0.3%
- 3. What is the cost of rewashing surgical instruments for the Trust in terms of time and resource?

The cost of rewashing is incorporated into our total costs so there is no set price for a wash process.

4. How often does contamination of surgical instruments interfere with or prevent a surgery from taking place?

The percentage of operations being cancelled due to this reason is so minimal that it would not show as a percentage.
