Dear Sir/Madam

Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting
- Are you using private debt firms to recover treatment costs from overseas patients ineligible for free NHS treatment?
 Yes.
- In the latest year you have data available for, how much money did you recover from ineligible patients, and how much was the total debt?

Please note that the credits do not necessarily relate to the invoices raised in the month.

September 2021 – August 2022

Total invoices = £631,000

Total credits = £573,000

Net invoices = (£631,000-£573,000) = £58,000

Total payments received = £89,000

Please note that in this period the Trust has raised credit notes totalling £573,000 although these credits do not necessarily relate to the invoices raised in this period and may relate to invoices raised before September 2021. The net invoices raised figure is therefore £58,000. Total monies received in the period September 2021 to August 2022 is £89,000 (greater than the net invoice value, this is because the payments may relate to invoices raised in period and previous periods.

- In the latest year you have data available for, how much money did you spend on fees for private debt firms to help recover payment from patients ineligible for free NHS treatment?

£3800 (September 2021 - August 2022)
