Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

## **Emergency Departments**

Data required (for period between 1st January 2022 and 31st December 2022)

• We require the gender of the patient (M or F), the date that they attended due to assault (dd/mm/yyyy) and their age. Age can either be numerical to the nearest year (preferred) or in age bands ("0-10", "11-17", "18-30", "31-50", "51+"), we can also accept date of birth.

We have provided the data for the period 1st January 2022 – 31st December 2022. Due to patient confidentiality, we are not providing the date attended data as we have considered that there is the

potential for the individuals to be identified when considered with other information that may be in the public domain. In our view disclosure of information would breach the Data Protection Act. Therefore, please find that Section 40(2) exemption contained within the Freedom of Information Act 2000 is engaged. Section 40 is the exemption for personal information.

This figures above do not include data from Weston General Hospital. The coding system used there is different. Please note, the Trust does not hold the data in a format that would enable us to fully respond to your request to the level of detail required and a manual trawl for this information would significantly exceed the 18 hours limit set down by the FOI as the reasonable limit. Section 12 of the FOIA provides that we are not obliged to spend in excess of 18 hours in any sixty-day period locating, retrieving and identifying information in order to deal with a request for information and therefore we are withholding this information at this time.

Please note: Where the figures are between 1 and 5, this has been denoted by \*. Due to the low numbers, we have considered that there is the potential for individuals to be identified from the information provided, when considered with other information that may also be in the public domain. In our view disclosure of these low figures would breach one of the Data Protection Principles set out in Schedule 1 of the Data Protection Act, namely Principle 1. The Trust therefore finds that the Section 40(2) exemption contained within the Freedom of information Act 2000 is engaged. (Section 40 is the exemption for personal information).

- To calculate the level of assault-related injury in England and Wales we also require the total number of attendances for any reason in the year of interest, i.e., 2022. 194,530
- Please also include the names of hospitals (including Minor Injury Units and Walk-in Centres) providing assault data.
