Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- We can confirm that we do not hold the information you are requesting
- 1. How many/what percentage of patients who had their first endocrinology consultant appointment in May 2019 were still waiting for diagnosis on 15 February 2023 (or the nearest available date)?
- 2. The patients who had their first endocrinology consultant appointment in May 2019:
- 2.1. how many patients were diagnosed with primary parathyroidism? (If "0" or very low figures, please apply to April-May or April-May-June instead)
- 2.2. what was the waiting time between the first appointment and the diagnosis: median/range?
- 2.3. the patients who were referred for parathyroidectomy how long was their waiting time between referral to surgery and the surgery: median/range?
- 2.4. how many patients from this cohort are still waiting for parathyroidectomy?
- 3. What was the waiting time between the referral to surgery and the surgery for the patients who had parathyroidectomy in January-February 2020: median/range?
- 4. What was the waiting time for parathyroidectomy in October 2021; February 2022?
- 5. What was the total number of parathyroidectomies in 2021-2022? Please list by provider and surgeon.
- 6. How long was the waiting time between the first appointment and the diagnosis of primary hyperthyroidism in 2021; 2022? (median/range)

- 7. How many parathyroidectomies in Q5
- a) caused the vocal cord damage,
- b) were unsuccessful in treating the hyperparathyroidism and/or resulted in complications? Please list by surgeon.
- 8. What was the waiting time from the first appointment to surgery for patients who had parathyroidectomy in December 2022-January 2023: median/range?
- 9. How many patients were on the waiting list for parathyroidectomy in January 2023?
- 10. What was the waiting time for parathyroidectomy in January 2023?
- 11. How many patients were referred for parathyroidectomy to other trusts and/or private providers and paid for by the Trust, in 2019; 2021; 2022? Please list by provider and surgeon.
- 12. How many patients in total received treatment under the S2 funding route (or its predecessor) in 2019; 2020; 2021; 2022?
- 13. How many parathyroidectomies took place under the S2 funding route in 2019; 2020; 2021; 2022?
- 14. Please list names of providers and surgeons for parathyroidectomies in Q13
