Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting

Could please share any data on msk/physiotherapy outpatient waiting times. The data I am requesting is specifically on qualitative (e.g. opinions from different stakeholders on waiting times) and/or quantitative data e.g. yearly mean/median average of waiting times within the past 5-10 years. I am happy to receive the data in any format you choose. If this is too specific, I am also happy to receive any qualitative/quantitative data on any of the areas for improvement for any specific physiotherapy service that you are aware of.

The mean average wait, in days, for a New Patient appointment with MSK outpatients for the last five years is as below:

Year Attending	Average Days Wait
2018	42
2019	36
2020	33
2021	32
2022	25

From a qualitative perspective:

We have not gathered specific qualitative data from patients relating to waiting times since 2018. At this time, 81% of patients surveyed felt that the waiting times were acceptable.

Waiting times for patients prioritised as routine has increased significantly since 2019/2020

due to service issues relating to the COVID-19 pandemic. We regularly report waiting times to primary and secondary care referrers and are actively working as MSK outpatient therapy providers within Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire to reduce waiting times across the region.
