A patient or somebody acting on their behalf can access the health records held by University Hospitals Bristol and Weston NHS Foundation Trust (UHBW). The request made for health records is called a Subject Access Request (SAR), as set out under Article 15 of the UK GDPR 2021. The request should be made digitally via the UHBW SAR Portal

What tools do you use to ensure that what needs to be redacted from patient records is redacted when responding to SARs?

Adobe

How do you share/send personal/patient information with insurance companies or solicitors when you receive such a request?

Through the Trust's secure file cloud called BOLT.
