Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting

I am requesting the following information in relation to the contract you have with Glanso and Alliance Medical Ltd under the FOI Act for the financial years 2020/21, 2021/22 and 2022/23

Please provide the average tariff for operations carried out for each company.

This is commercially sensitive information and will not be shared at an organisational level. Section 43 of the FOI Act provides that information is exempt if its disclosure would, or would be likely to prejudice the commercial interests of any person. Therefore we are withholding this information at this time.

Public Interest Test:

When assessing whether or not it was in the public interest to disclose the information to you, we took into account the following factors:

Public interest considerations favouring disclosure

There is a public interest in disclosing information to facilitate accountability and transparency in the spending of public money.

There is a public interest in ensuring that companies are able to compete fairly.

There is also a public interest in ensuring that this is competition for public sector contracts.

Public interest considerations favouring withholding the information

Against disclosure is that the release of the requested information is commercially sensitive in that disclosing this information would reduce the number of companies willing to do business with the public sector, leading to reduced competition and increased costs.

Against disclosure is the public interest is the potential that by releasing the requested information would or would prejudice someone's commercial interests i.e. damage a

company's reputation or the confidence that customers, suppliers or investors may have in a company.

Please also provide the average tariff paid to the NHS for week-day operations.

We are able to obtain this information however we have decided to apply **Section 21** of the FOIA as this information is reasonably accessible in the public domain on the following link on the NHS England website: [22-23NT AnnexA-National-tariff-workbook-Nov22-1.xlsx \(live.com\)](#). Section 21 of the FOIA provides that we are not obliged to provide the requested information is already reasonably accessible and therefore we are withholding this information at this time.

I am also applying for the latest contract for Glanso and Alliance Medical Ltd.

We do not have a contract with Alliance Medical Ltd.

Please see the attached contract for Glanso.
