Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting

Would you be able to confirm if:

- paper notes/drug charts are used anywhere in the trust, alongside electronic paper notes/drug charts?

Yes.

- if so, are there any plans to migrate away from paper to electronic? if not, how often is the decision reviewed?

Yes.

- if so, does the trust keep track of serious incidents etc related to paper specifically eg misreading of handwritten comments/doses?

The Trust keeps track of serious incidents but there is no specific category on our local risk management system nor the national Strategic Executive Management System (StEIS) to record serious incidents related to paper notes.

- How many incidents happened within the last year (or period the trust tracks)?

Three serious incidents were reported during 2022/23 as below:

No notes in file – assumed missing.

Misreading of corrected medication dose.

Missing drug chart led to delay in giving medication.

These are not reported under a specific category and have been identified using the search terms specified in the request.

- if not, how long ago did the trust migrate away from paper notes?

Not applicable.
