Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

This is an information request relating to Pride Month.

Please include the following information:

• Whether any events have been organised for Pride month. If so please provide the date, start and end time, and title/topic of the event

University Hospitals Bristol and Weston NHS Foundation Trust will be raising the pride flag in Bristol and Weston sites to show support to members and allies of the LGBTQIA+ community.

- Whether any LGBT themed merchandise has been purchased for Pride month. i.e. since the beginning of the 2023/24 financial year. If so please provide me with information on what has been purchased and the cost None.
- Whether the organisation has sponsored any Pride events. If so which events and please provide details of the nature of the sponsorship (particularly the financial value) In partnership with other NHS and care organisations in the Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire Integrated Care System (ICS), colleagues from the Trust will be attending the Bristol Pride event on Saturday 8 July. They will take part in the parade march and have a stall to promote the Trust as an inclusive employer. The cost incurred for both events is £300 and includes the cost of the stall and the production of a joint ICS banner. No merchandise has been purchased for these events.
