Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting
- 1. Yearly incidence of extravasation injury in your trust.

157 (between 1st July 2022 - 30th June 2023).

2. The roles and numbers of staff involved in extravasation management per case in your trust.

This would be mainly nursing staff. We cannot provide a number for the number of staff involved, as extravasation injury can happen on any unit where IV medicine is given.

3. Whether your trust has an extravasation treatment algorithm/protocol and what it entails?

Yes, there are two protocols; one for cytotoxic extravasation and one for non-cytotoxic extravasation.

- 4. Whether your trust has compulsory DATIX reporting of extravasation injuries? Yes
- 5. If your trust has compulsory DATIX reporting of extravasation injuries, how many incidents have been reported for the last 5 years (1st January 2018 to 1st January 2023)?

2018 - 86

2019 - 112

2020 - 100

2021 - 122

2022 - 127
