- **Was the session delivered (even if only partially) by someone external to the Trust?**

LGBTQIA+ Awareness developed outside of the Trust. The other 2 were developed by staff within the trust. None of the training is delivered face to face and is all self-directed learning.

- **If so, who?**

"LGBTQIA+ Awareness" eLearning session was produced by eLearning for Healthcare / NHS England

- **How much was paid to them for this?**

Zero.

For "gender identity", please include any training which is likely to include a significant amount of content about transgender and non-binary people (and related LGBT+ issues). Therefore, if the training is entitled "Why is Pride important?", or "Supporting

LGBT+ patients”, or “Using pronouns”, these are each likely to include information about gender identity, and I would like you to include them.
