1. For the past five years, how many STI postal test kits were sent out to service users from your sexual health service? I would like the data from the financial years 2018 to 2019, 2019 to 2020, 2020 to 2021, 2021 to 2022, 2022 to 2023?

2. On average for each year specified, what was the proportion of tests successfully returned to the trust? If there is an estimated range, please provide as an estimated range.

2019/2020	56.07%
2020/2021	64.39%
2021/2022	65.96%
2022/2023	59.08%

3. What is the total overall cost spent by your NHS trust on all STI tests to send out and process, including pathology (the cost of processing the samples) each year? I would like the data from the financial years 2018 to 2019, 2019 to 2020, 2020 to 2021, 2021 to 2022, 2022 to 2023?

Financial year	Total overall cost
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2018/2019	£203,999.83
2019/2020	£305,948.59
2020/2021	£469,079.14
2021/2022	£406,486.93
2022/2023	£386,334.53

For example during the financial year 2018 to 2019, the total cost of: £800,000 was spent.
