Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting
- 1. The number of FTE funded midwife posts there are for each maternity service at your trust?

197.78 WTE plus 3 WTE Midwifery Matrons

1 WTE Director of Midwifery and Nursing,

1 WTE Deputy Director of Nursing

- 2.6 WTE Patient Safety Midwives and 1.6 WTE Safeguarding Midwives
- 2. The number of FTE funded midwife posts for each maternity service at your trust which were vacant as of the start of August 2023 (excluding those on maternity or long term sick leave where sick leave has lasted for one month or longer)?

 16.6 WTE
- 3. The number of FTE funded midwife posts for each maternity service at your trust which were vacant as of 1st May 2023 (excluding those on maternity or long term sick leave where sick leave has lasted for one month or longer)?

 13.67 WTE
- 4. The date of the most recent Birthrate Plus study of midwifery staffing for each service within your trust?

5. The number of FTE funded midwife posts that Birthrate Plus recommended your trust employ for each maternity service at your trust?

181 WTE Band 5 to 7 plus specialist midwives. We are funded to Birthrate Plus recommendations.

6. For each of the last five years, how many red flag events have been recorded for each

of the trust's maternity services?

The 'red flags' we have relating to midwifery staffing are categorised under

1:1 Care

From 2018 – 2023 there were 11 red flag events

Delay of 30 minutes presentation to triage

From 2018 – 2032 the total number was * red flag events

Please note: Where the figures are between 1 and 5, this has been denoted by *. Due to the low numbers, we have considered that there is the potential for individuals to be identified from the information provided, when considered with other information that may also be in the public domain. In our view disclosure of these low figures would breach one of the Data Protection Principles set out in Schedule 1 of the Data Protection Act, namely Principle 1. The Trust therefore finds that the Section 40(2) exemption contained within the Freedom of information Act 2000 is engaged. (Section 40 is the exemption for personal information).

-Delayed time critical activity

From 2018 – 2023 there were 11 red flag events

Please note that Trusts set their own red flags so the data cannot be compared to other Trusts.
