Operation note creation is mixed practice across the Trust, with some teams using electronic notes within Careflow Electronic Patient Records, and others using dedicated specialist software.and others handwriting notes. Handwritten operation notes get scanned and uploaded to Evolve at the end of a clinical spell.

4. If you have an urology department:

- What software system is used to track the JJ stents (Excel, other 3rd party software)

- What system or software is used to monitor patients with prostate cancer on active surveillance.~
