Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

### How many patients are currently on your trust's waiting list for a cancer diagnostic test?

As at 22/10/2023 there were 2695 patients on an open pathway following a GP suspected cancer referral and without a decision to treat. Many, but not all, of these will be waiting for diagnostic tests. It is not possible to provide the precise figure waiting for diagnostics as opposed to other types of step (such as an outpatient appointment or test results). Please note there may also be some patients waiting for diagnostics who are not on this type of cancer pathway, but it is not possible to accurately quantify those.

# How many patients were on your trust's waiting list for a cancer diagnostic test 12 months ago?

As at 24/10/2022 there were 2494 patients on an open pathway following a GP suspected cancer referral and without a decision to treat. Many, but not all, of these will be waiting for diagnostic tests. It is not possible to provide the precise figure waiting for diagnostics as opposed to other types of step (such as an outpatient appointment or test results). Please note there may also be some patients waiting for diagnostics who are not on this type of cancer pathway, but it is not possible to accurately quantify those.

# What is the longest time a patient has had to wait for a cancer diagnostic test in the last 12 months?

We do not hold this information as we are unable to reliably identify a 'cancer diagnostic' test for all modalities of test. Also tests requested as cancer priority may not be for diagnostic purposes.
