Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

• We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting

I would like to request the following information to be released, if held, with regards to the Patient Initiated Digital Mutual Aid System (PIDMAS).

- The number of patients who had been on a waiting list for treatment with the trust for **40 weeks or more, as of 31 October 2023.** 10,378

- The number of patients contacted by the trust to tell them of their eligibility to choose a different provider or health trust through PIDMAS, as of 1 December 2023. 2,783

The number of patients who have been referred to another provider or health trust, through PIDMAS, as of 1 December 2023.

The programme has not yet progressed to this stage so currently zero patients have been referred.
