Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

Please can you indicate in the table below which services, if any, your organisation procures and advise who currently provides that service. Please confirm the current contract end date, how many journeys are conducted per annum (including aborts, excluding cancelled), the approximate spend per annum and lastly, please indicate how many months in the previous 12 they achieve their Inbound and Outbound KPI targets.

If you are answering on behalf of multiple sites/Trusts or geographical areas please state which and if the contracts differ between these please complete a separate table as appropriate.

Non-emergency patient transport services (NEPTS) are in general commissioned by Integrated Care Boards (ICB), rather than the Trust, and therefore there is a diverse range of providers and services relating to patients attending our sites. The Trust provides both secondary and tertiary clinical care, and therefore treats patients from a wide geographical area. As each ICB is able to commission individually, patient journeys to and from our Trust fall within many different contracts. The activity and costs relating to these contracts is not all within the Trust's dataset and therefore cannot be shared in this response. The Trust has a no-guaranteed-activity contract in place with Bristol Ambulance, to ensure appropriate governance is in place for any journeys required which are outside the scope or capacity of the ICB-commissioned providers. This contract has been in place since 2020 and runs for five years with an option for a two-year extension. The activity for the year April 2022 to March 2023 delivered through this contract is as follows:
