Dear Sir/Madam

Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting

I am requesting freedom of information on whether you run allergy clinics and how long your waiting list is please. Specifically, if a patient has an allergic response to something and is then referred for a drug challenge within the hospital environment, and how long they would have to wait if they were put to the bottom of the queue.

We have approximately an 11-12 month wait for a new routine allergy appointment, but urgent patients are seen around 4-6 weeks. The current wait for a drug challenge is around nine months, although urgent patients would be expedited depending on clinical urgency as determined by the consultant.

This concludes our response. We trust that you find this helpful, but please do not hesitate to contact us directly if we can be of any further assistance.

If, after that, you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to:
