Of the ovarian patients diagnosed over the last 6 months, how many have been treated with the below:

Paclitaxel in combination with a platinum-based compound: 10

Platinum-based therapy alone (cisplatin or carboplatin): 9

Bevacizumab in combination with paclitaxel and carboplatin: 1

Olaparib: 2 Niraparib: 0 Rucaparib: 0

Pegylated liposomal doxorubicin hydrochloride (PLDH) as monotherapy or in

combination with a platinum-based compound: 0

5. Question 5

Of those who were positive for a BRCA mutation, how many received Olaparib for 1st line maintenance?

2 patients.

6. Question 6

Of those who were positive for a BRCA mutation, how many received Bevacizumab in combination with paclitaxel and carboplatin for 1st line maintenance?
