Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

We can confirm that we do hold some of the information you are requesting.

Simon Stevens and Amanda Pritchard wrote to all NHS trusts and CCG Chief Executives on the 29th of April to advise that employers, on a precautionary basis, should conduct risk assessments for staff at greater risk during the COVID-19 pandemic and to act accordingly.

1. Has your organisation completed risk assessments on all Black Asian and Minority Ethnic (BAME) staff?

All departments have undertaken detailed risk assessments of both staff and their working environments to ensure any staff at risk are identified and bespoke reasonable adjustments are put in place where required.

2. What precautions, if any, have you put in place to protect BAME staff once they've been risk assessed?"

The risk assessments were conducted on a one to one basis between the manager and their member of staff. There have been a number of reasonable adjustments put in place as a result of these conversations and they were agreed with the individuals affected as appropriate. It would take the Trust more than 18 hours to detail on each adjustment and this response is therefore exempt from disclosure under section 12 of the FOI Act 2000.

If, after that, you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to:
