Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

Total Locum Agency Spend £1,793k, of which £1,010k was Consultants and £783k other medical grades. The majority of all medical agency spend was in Emergency and general medical areas including £268k in Dermatology.

2. Can you confirm if any agency locum doctors have been in contract for 6 months or longer? Can you break down by specialty and grade.

There has not been any contract with an agency for locum doctors.

3. Please can you give me the breakdown of bank doctor spend in the past 12 months? Please break this down by specialty and grade.

Total bank doctor spend £2,473k of which £823k was Consultants, £1572k was Other medical grades and £78k was Dental. A majority of all medical bank expenditure was in ED and General Medical areas.

4. Please can you give me a breakdown of permanent or fixed term doctor vacancies across the Trust? Please break down by specialty and grade.
