Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

We neither confirm nor deny if we hold the information you are requesting.

- How many canisters of Nitrous Oxide have been stolen from your Trust since January 1 2010?
 Four.
- 2. From which locations where the canisters stolen? Please note that under Section 31 (Law Enforcement) of the Freedom of Information Act, some of the information is exempt from disclosure if its disclosure under this Act would, or would be likely to prejudice-the prevention or detection of crime. In this case, the public test interest relates to the ability of the Trust to not disclose information about crime references, locations and exact dates that thefts have occurred, as identified vulnerabilities could be exploited for criminal means.
- 3. What was the volume of the canisters stolen? Four size E canisters (1800 litres).
- 4. When were the canisters stolen? In 02/2016.
- 5. What was the value of the canisters stolen? The cost is commercial in confidence as it is under contract.

Which Police force - if any - was the theft reported to? If possible could a CRN/Crime Reference Number for each incident be provided as well. The Trust confirms that the Avon and Somerset police was informed. Crime ref no 5216024208.
