Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting.

1. Number of patients treated for Hepatic Veno Occlusive Disease (ICD-10 K765) and their age at the time of treatment.

2. Number of patients diagnosed with VOD and treated with defibrotide split by patient criteria, by age and by transplant type.

Please note that the Trust cannot report on drug treatment per diagnosis. To identify this information it would take the Trust more than 18 hours to complete as it would require manual trawl of individual notes and it is therefore exempt from disclosure under section 12 of the FOI Act 2000.
