We are able to provide the number of hospital inpatients in the last five years who had a diagnosis for Inherited Retinal Dystrophy (IC10 code H35.5).

## 2. What is the total number of Inherited Retinal Dystrophy patients that attended an Ophthalmology clinic within your Trust in the four-month period from Nov 2019-Feb 2020?

We do not hold this information as we do not record diagnosis in outpatients and it would take more than 18 hours to obtain the information. Disclosure is therefore exempt under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
