Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

Within the period of the financial year 2019-2020 and within the general medicine and general surgery on call specialist registrar rotas I wish to know how many staff were employed (excluding less than full time staff). For these staff I wish to know their grade (or grade equivalent), whether they are trust grade/locally employed, their annual gross salary including any uplifts for on call work (and excluding any locum payments) and their nationality, gender and age.

A reference table is attached to this email, showing the format of the information requested.

General Medicine - Please note, the Trust does not hold the data in a format that would enable us to fully respond to your request to the level of detail required and a manual trawl for this information would significantly exceed the 18 hours limit set down by the FOI as the reasonable limit. Section 12 of the FOIA provides that we are not obliged to spend in excess of 18 hours in any sixty day period locating, retrieving and identifying information in order to deal with a request for information and therefore we are withholding this information at this time.
