# **Freedom of Information Request**

Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting

I can see the figures that you publish online, but these are deaths within 28 days of a positive Covid-19 test, so they could have died from other causes.

I just want to know the exact figures between 1st February 2020 until the 31st December 2020 for the following questions:

### **Question 1**

How many people have died in each of your hospitals between 1st February 2020 until the 31st December 2020?

We are able to obtain this information however we have decided to apply Section 21 of the FOIA as this information is reasonably accessible in the public domain on the following link: https://www.england.nhs.uk/statistics/statistical-work-areas/covid-19-daily-deaths/

Section 21 of the FOIA provides that we are not obliged to provide the requested information is already reasonably accessible and therefore we are withholding this information at this time

### **Question 2**

How many people have died in your hospitals from Covid-19 alone between 1st February 2020 until the 31st December 2020?

(As in they died ONLY due to Covid-19 and did not have any comorbidities at the time of death.)

### with the Data filtered:

By Hospital showing deaths per month per hospital between 1st February 2020 until the 31st December 2020.

255 deaths (comorbiditie). We are unable to break it down as requested

# **Question 3**

How many people have died in your hospitals from Covid-19 between 1st February 2020 until the 31st December 2020?

(As in they died due to Covid-19 but they did have comorbidities at the time of their death.)

## with the Data filtered:

- By Hospital showing deaths per month per hospital between 1st February 2020 until the 31st December 2020.

9 deaths (no comorbidities). We are unable to break it down as requested
