Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting

Please can you provide the pathway for oncology patients who have developed thromboembolism. I believe this pathway is referred to as the cancer associated thromboembolism pathway (CAT). I am after where patients admit, where they are treated and with what medication plus what if any follow ups are in place.

Re oncology patients who have developed thromboembolism:

- Where patients admit: Acute Admissions Unit (AAU), Clinical nurse specialist (CNS) team, via radiologist contacting the responsible consultant, (Community) via doctor contacting deep vein thrombosis (DVT) nurses in Bristol Royal Infirmary & the vascular laboratory
- Where patients are treated: anticoagulation arranged with either the GP, CNS team, BRI DVT nurse or by the AAU team
- What medication are patients treated with: The majority of patients on pre-existing anticoagulation will be on oral drugs Warfarin, DOACs (Direct Oral AntiCoagulants also known as NOACs).
- What if any follow ups are in place: Patients are generally on follow up in the oncology / haematology clinics already so this just continues
