 - 7. The number of adults (over the age of 18) with an ADHD diagnosis who are also being treated for a psychiatric comorbidity, including, but not limited to: depression, anxiety, personality disorders such as borderline personality disorder, sleep disorders and substance abuse.**
 - a. Please provide this as a breakdown by comorbidity**

Please could you also provide the average wait time for each year from 2015-2020, if doing so will not push this request over the cost limit.
