Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting
- 1. Who in University Hospitals Bristol and Weston NHS Foundation Trust has overall responsibility for auditing/monitoring insider threats counter fraud? (Name and email address if possible).

Although the Trust has an accredited Local Counter Fraud Specialist, Elias Hayes, elias.hayes@uhbw.nhs.uk who is responsible for the day to day counter fraud duties, the executive responsibility sits with the Director of Finance and Information.

2. Do you have a Counter Fraud Champion? If yes, what is their name and email address?

The Trust's Counter Fraud Champion is Head of Finance (People and Governance)

3. How is University Hospitals Bristol and Weston NHS Foundation Trust able to check that your IT systems are being used in the way that they should?

4. In the last 5 years, how many employees have misused their authority and used your IT systems inappropriately - e.g.: to identify vulnerable people, falsify records, make false claims etc?

The Trust does not hold the data in a format that would enable us to fully respond to your request to the level of detail required and a manual trawl for this information would significantly exceed the 18 hours limit set down by the FOI as the reasonable limit. Section 12 of the FOIA provides that we are not obliged to spend in excess of 18 hours in any sixty-day period locating, retrieving and identifying information in order to deal with a request for information and therefore we are withholding this information at this time.

5. In the last 5 years, how many employees have been investigated under the Fraud Act 2006 and subsequently been found to have actually committed fraud.

Merged organisation (since 2020/21):

• 8 employees

UHB and WAHT pre-merger since 06/01/2017:

• 28 employees

3 employees found to have committed fraud offences since 06/01/2017, although none satisfied criminal trial, only civil recovery.

6. How much money has University Hospitals Bristol and Weston NHS Foundation Trust lost as a result of insider fraud/corruption in the last 5 years? NHS Counter Fraud Authority estimate that the NHS is vulnerable to £1.21 billion worth of fraud each year and I would like to understand how that relates to Sheffield Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust. For clarity, I would like to know the total amount whether subsequently recovered or not.

Although a true figure cannot be identified due to the hidden nature of fraud, which can only be quantified once reported, fraud proven in this period through insider fraud/corruption = £6,187.34. Please note that the £1.21billion quoted by NHSCFA relates to staff, contractor, patient and NHS systems fraud. NHS contractor, patient and system frauds often amount to higher values than insider fraud, due to the nature of NHS contracts and cost of services for those who are not eligible for free NHS care.

7. How often do you have to audit your IT systems to make sure employees are using them appropriately?
