1. Number of primary cleft lip operations carried out each month in 2019, 2020 and 2021?

For clarification - number of times primary lip or palate surgery was carried out in other hospitals such as Swansea Newcastle and GOSH with all other care planned to be carried out in Bristol. (not an exhaustive location list and surgery not as a result of patient relocation)

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6. Number of times primary cleft lip and palate operations we cancelled in 2019, 2020 and 2021?

2019 95

2020 48

2021 63

Please note although the request asks for a monthly breakdown a significant number of months covered had fewer than cancellations, so it made more sense to just summarise them by year.

7. Number of complains to UHBW about the timing of surgery for primary cleft lip and palate surgery in 2014, 2015, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021?

2014/15 = 0 2015/16 = 1 2016/17 = 0 2017/18 = * 2018/19 = 0 2019/20 = * 2020/21 = 6 2021/22 to date = * Please note: Where the figures are between 1 and 5, this has been denoted by *. Due to the low numbers, we have considered that there is the potential for individuals to be identified from the information provided, when considered with other information that may also be in the public domain. In our view disclosure of these low figures would breach one of the Data Protection Principles set out in Schedule 1 of the Data Protection Act, namely Principle 1. The Trust therefore finds that the Section 40(2) exemption contained within the Freedom of information Act 2000 is engaged. (Section 40 is the exemption for personal information).
