Approximately 550 procedures.

Q5: Which cell salvage apparatus (make, model and quantities and location) are currently used in sites performing cell salvage within the trust?

Sorin Xtra machines (4 in the Bristol Royal Infirmary, 1 in Bristol Royal Hospital for Children (Cardiac) and 1 in Bristol Royal Hospital for Children (Neurology)

St Michael's Hospital have Fresenius machines: CATS Plus machine (active in 2021). We now have an additional CATS Smart machine which we will start using shortly once all staff trained.

Q6: Which surgical specialties perform cell salvage (eg cardiac, orthopaedics etc)?

Cardiac
