Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

• We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting

Do you provide free parking for NHS staff and/or patients?

University Hospitals Bristol and Weston NHS Foundation Trust have not reintroduced parking charges for staff that meet the eligibility criteria to park on site. However where staff do park off site they pay charges according to the off site car park provider tariff. To protect car parking spaces for patients, charges were reintroduced in July 2020 and the current tariff is:

- First 30 minutes is free
- up to 1 hour £1.80
- 1-2 hours £3.40
- 2-4 hours £5.80
- 4-6 hours £7.10
- 6-8 hours £12:00
- over 8 hours £15:00

All disabled parking is free, and the Trust also provide parking to the categories outlined in the NHS parking guidelines 2021 as well as discounted parking for visitors of inpatients. Parking is also free for patients and visitors after 18:00 Monday to Sunday.

If not, how much do you charge staff to park?

No decision has been made by the Trust about when staff car parking charges will be reintroduced and what the charge will be.

How long does it take for staff to be issued a permit when joining your trust?

Car parking applications have to go through an approvals process which could take anything up to seven days.
