- 3. How many Remote Cardiac device follow-ups were performed in your trust over the last 12 months (Aug21-Aug 22) 1,593
- 4. Do you perform In-office clinics at multiple locations Yes
- 5. How many In-office Cardiac Device follow-up clinics do you perform per week across all trust sites 6,542
- 6. How long are your appointment slots for In-Office cardiac device follow-up (mins) 25 minutes
- 7. How do you currently record and report Implantable Cardiac Device Follow-Up information
