b. If yes, could you please provide the number of GreenLight procedures completed at you your Trust in the fiscal year 2021/2022

3. Have you ever offered both HoLEP and GreenLight simultaneously as a surgical intervention for patients with Benign Prostate Enlargement at your Trust? a. If yes, what is the exact date (at least month and year) that your Urology department began to offer both treatment options to patients (and end date if applicable)?

4. Have you ever offered transurethral resection of the prostate (TURP) as a surgical intervention for patients with Benign Prostate Enlargement at your Trust? a. If yes, could you please provide the number of operations completed at your Trust in the fiscal year 2021/2022
