Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

• We can confirm that we hold some of the information you are requesting

• When is the current contract for IOLs (Intraocular lenses) in Ophthalmology up for renewal? Please provide contract end date and extension options.

This has expired and we are now using NHSSC framework contract.

• When is your Phaco machinery (for cataracts) contract up for renewal? Please provide contract end date and extension options.

The original contract expired 2 years ago; however, the machines are still supported for 3 years.

• When is your VR machinery (for vitreoretinal) contract up for renewal? Please provide contract end date and extension options.

The original contract has expired as above, we are currently re-procuring using NHSSC ophthalmology framework contract.

• What is your current Route to Market for IOLs, Phaco and VR? NHSSC framework

• When does your procurement department plan to actively start in pretender engagement for IOLs, Phaco and VR? Please include the date. This is current but via NHSSC - no direct engagement.
