Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting

**I would be most grateful if you would provide me, under the Freedom of Information Act, details in respect to your current web filtering / proxy contract.**

**The details we require are:**

- **Who is your current provider for this contract?**
- **When is the contract renewal date?**
- **Actual spend on this contract/framework (and any sub lots), from the start of the contract to the current date**
- **Start date & duration of framework/contract?**
- **Is there an extension clause in the framework(s)/contract(s) and, if so, the duration of the extension?**
- **Has a decision been made yet on whether the framework(s)/contract(s) are being either extended or renewed?**
- **Who is the senior officer (outside of procurement) responsible for this contract?**

University Hospitals Bristol and Weston NHS Foundation Trust can neither confirm nor deny whether information is held under section 31(3) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Under Section 31(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act, we are required to judge as to whether the disclosure of the information would, or would be likely to, prejudice the prevention or detection of crime. Under guidance issued by the Information Commissioner states that this exemption applies if disclosure of the withheld information would, or would be likely to prejudice the prevention of criminal acts in relation to the Trust's computer systems and information, such as hacking, theft of data, misuse of confidential data or the disruption of the Trust's operations.

If, after that, you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to:
