I am expecting the data in table format, with years in the rows, and then a column for the trust as a whole, as well as a column for each hospital you serve. Please provide me:

1) The total £ amount spent on patient meals. I would like a figure for just the food / ingredients, without including staff costs or equipment.

Provide this as an average over the year, along with a note on the method used to work this out if possible.

It is calculated by dividing the total amount spent on meals by the total number of meals served, then multiplying that figure by three (assumes each patient receives three meals a day). We do not have data for 2023/24 yet.
