3. What was the annual cost for the Trust's current Allied Health Professionals job planning software in 2023 to 2024

4. What was the annual cost for the Trust's current medics job planning software in 2023 to 2024

This is commercially sensitive information and will not be shared at an organisational level. Therefore we are withholding this information at this time.

5. What is the contractual end date of your current Allied Health Professionals job planning software
