Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

We can confirm that we do hold some of the information you are requesting

## For the last 3 financial years:

How many radiology imaging examinations do you perform a year in total? (i.e. the total number of MRIs, CTs, X-rays, ultrasounds etc) 329,881

How many radiology imaging examinations (studies) do you share with patients a year? We do not hold this information.

How many subject access requests related to patient medical data do you receive a year?

**2021/2022**: 2238 **2022/2023**: 2895 **2023/2024**: 3895

How many requests in total do you receive for patient access to medical data a year?

**2021/2022**: 588 **2022/2023**: 864 **2023/2024**: 1420

How many requests in total do you receive for patient access to radiology images a

year?

**2021/2022**: 67 **2022/2023**: 141 **2023/2024**: 350

When you fulfil a patient request for radiology images, what is the method you use to give patients the images?

How many CDs do you send to patients with their images on a year? Between 1-5 per year.

How many USBs do you send to patients with their images on a year? None

How many links do you send for patients to access their images on the IEP a year? **2023/2024**: 350

Please note that the Trust started using IEP approximately one year ago

Are there other ways you give patients their images a year? Prior to 2023, the images were burned to a CD

What is the economic cost to you for the IEP service a year? Approximately £17,376

What is the economic cost of burning radiology images onto CDs a year? We do not hold this information.
