Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting
- 1. Do you have private penalty charge notice issuing capabilities on your NHS property? (do you have ticket officers)

2. Were you aware the council is issuing PCN notices on your property?

The council are able to issue PCNs at the far end of Montague Hill South as it outside of the Trust boundary defined by a bold white line and there is no parking space there.

3. Please can you confirm whether the trust owns Montague Hills South as part of the BRI complex.

Yes, as far as the bold white line which defines the end of the Trust's boundary. Bristol City Council own the section of the road from the junction with Dighton Street up until the white line on the corner as shown in the image on the following link:
