How many of those injured were in the 50-64 age group? • How many of those injured were in the 65+ age group? How many of those injured required prolonged stays in hospital? • How many of this injury type did you receive in: 2023 2022 2021

We are unable to provide this information. Our system captures information under a 'presenting complaint' freetext field. This field does not contain sufficient information to be confident of capturing solely DIY activity, and not all activity due to DIY is captured. It is

therefore not possible to isolate incidences of injuries sustained whilst participating in DIY activities.
