Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- We can confirm that we hold some of the information you are requesting
- 1. Total Spend and Volumes: The total spend (in £) and volume (number of procedures) for both in-house and outsourced provisions for each of the following ophthalmology procedure groups:
- **o Cataract surgeries** We do not hold the cost data at the level required as cataract surgery is carried out on cataract operating lists, but also on mixed procedure lists and a mix of in week and weekend provision.
- **o AMD eye injections** we only undertake this procedure in medical retina clinics and there is a mix of one stop or two stop models; this is not delivered in generic clinics
- o AMD photodynamic therapy We do not undertake this procedure

LASIK – We do not undertake this procedure

SMILE - We do not undertake this procedure

o Corrective laser eye surgeries (e.g. PRK, LASEK, TransPRK) - We do not undertake these procedures
