I would like to request the following information under the Freedom of Information Act relating to the provision of care for babies with jaundice in your Trust

1. Do babies in the community have TcB (Transcutaneous) test when jaundice is suspected?

Yes

2. What level does the TcB need to be to indicate a blood test for Serum Bilirubin (TSB)?

More than 250

3. Where do the babies have the blood test for TSB (Total serum bilirubin) once jaundice has been identified in the community eg, at home, sent back to maternity or sent to paediatric unit

At home

4. If phototherapy is required, where is this carried out, in maternity or the paediatric unit?

Maternity unit
