Dear Sir/Madam

Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting

**Cross referencing has identified that University Hospitals Bristol and Weston NHS Foundation Trust provides healthcare in HMP & YOI Eastwood Park Prison. Specifically, my requests are as follows:**

**1. By year, how much money has been spent on assistive devices in University Hospitals Bristol and Weston NHS Foundation Trust, for inmates aged 50 or above, beginning with the year 2018 and ending with 2023? Please break down the data by prison and calendar year (i.e. 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023), and then by cost and by treatment/device/syndrome where possible.**

**Examples may include but are not limited to: wheelchairs; mobility scooters; walkers; stair assists; hearing aids; shoe horns; automatic pill dispensers; fall alarms; canes; prosthetic devices designed to replace a missing body part; visual aids like glasses; incontinence products like adult pads, pull-up pants, and catheters; dental prostheses like false teeth; inhalers; orthotic devices that prevent the worsening of arthritic diseases; etc.**

Please note, the Trust does not hold the data in a format that would enable us to fully respond to your request to the level of detail required and a manual trawl for this information would significantly exceed the 18 hours limit set down by the FOI as the reasonable limit. Section 12 of the FOIA provides that we are not obliged to spend in excess of 18 hours in any sixty-day period locating, retrieving and identifying information in order to deal with a request for information and therefore we are withholding this information at this time.

This concludes our response. We trust that you find this helpful, but please do not hesitate to contact us directly if we can be of any further assistance.

If, after that, you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to:
