Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

I am writing under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to formally request information regarding the volumes and spending on outsourced and insourced procedures within your trust.

I would like to receive data on the number of procedures (volume) and spend (£ value) for the financial years:

The requested information should be provided by provider for all the years combined and should include the following details:

Number of specialties: Whether single or multiple

Specialty: Specify if the provider only focuses on one (single) specialty

Whether the procedures were outsourced or insourced:

o Outsourced procedures: Delivered by an external (third-party) provider contracted by your trust, health board, or ICB, performed in their facility using their staff. o Insourced procedures: Delivered by an external provider contracted to perform

procedures using your facilities (e.g., operating theatres) but with their staff.

We are able to obtain this information however we have decided to apply Section 21 of the FOIA as this information is reasonably accessible in the public domain on the Trust's website on the following links:
