Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

• We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting

Can I please make a Freedom of Information request for details underpinning returns to the provisional national estates returns information collection database for 23/24 (found here) for clinical service incidents caused by estates and infrastructure failure related to Critical Infrastructure Risk.

This is defined as the "number of incidents at the site specifically related to critical infrastructure risk backlog maintenance caused by estates and infrastructure failure which resulted in clinical services being delayed, cancelled or otherwise interfered with owing to problems or failures related to the estates and infrastructure failure". Please provide details of each incident recorded in the 23/24 returns including: a) description of the estates issue, b) description of disruption caused, c)site and service affected and d) length of downtime

We are able to obtain this information however we have decided to apply Section 21 of the FOIA as this information is reasonably accessible in the public domain on the Trust's website on the following links:
