Dear Sir/Madam

Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

• We can confirm that we do hold the information you are requesting

1. Does your Trust have a process for skin preparation/cleaning prior to blood collection? Y/N

Yes

2. Do you take two sets of blood cultures each time as recommended in the guidance? Y/N

This is recommended but unclear if this happens. New sepsis guidelines are being developed which suggests two sets are taken at the initial encounter, but this will likely cause issues with capacity on the automated incubators.

3. If no, what percentage of patients do have two sets of blood cultures taken?

Approximately 20%. This is of course different when the patient has a central/ picc line as we will often get paired cultures (peripheral and line cultures).

4. Do you measure the volume of blood taken each time a blood culture is taken (the recommended amount is 20ml per sample)? No.

5. Do you measure the time between blood sample collection and the sample being loaded onto an analyser instrument (the recommended maximum time is four hours)? Yes

6. If yes, what is the average time?

February 2025 mean time was 3.3 hours.

7. Do you collect data on blood sample contamination?

8. Is the data described above reported at Board level as recommended?

The rates of contamination are. The loading times are discussed at the regional pathology network
