Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

On 9th June 2023 NHS England published an Interim service specification for services for children and young people with gender incongruence, accessible here:

In this document it specifies that service's outcomes should include:

- Evidence of engagement with children, young people and families in design and review of service delivery
- Collection and reporting of children and young people's experience of the service
- Build Patient Reported Outcome Measures (PROMs) and Patient Reported Experience Measures (PREMs) for routine deployment no later than one year following service initiation

Can you share the following information:

- What date did your Gender services commence?
   4th November 2024
- In what ways does your service engage with children, young people, and families to design and review service delivery?

We have recently launched PPI (Patient and public involvement) recruitment process (July 2025) to engage and consent young people and families to partake in PPI. A plan for engagement is currently under development, aiming to have key areas of focus to gather young people and families feedback on the service. There is shared learning from other services (London and North West) on aspects of the service that they have already received feedback on.

• In what way does your service collect and report children and young people's

## experience of the service?

Through outpatient questionnaires and feedback and also Patient Support and Complaints Team where complaints and compliments are logged through our Trust reporting system.

• What patient reported outcome measures and patient reported experience measures have you developed?

PROM – These are still under development.

PREM – as above via usual Trust Patient Experience measures.

In a meeting of the NHS England CYP Gender Education and Training Programme Group that took place on 29th January 2025, the Academy of Medical Royal Colleges reported that it planned to share the Holistic Assessment Framework module handbook and materials it has developed with CYP gender services. It also reported that it planned to co-design content for its Holistic Assessment Framework with CYP gender services.
