Council of Governors

Governors have an important role in making NHS Foundation Trusts publicly accountable for the services they provide. Governors have two key duties – to hold the non-executive directors to account for the performance of the Board, and to represent the interests of Foundation Trust members and the public. Membership of the Council is divided into public and staff constituencies, with governors being elected by Foundation Trust members in each constituency. We also have appointed governors who represent the interests of our local authority, Universities, the Trust's Joint Union Committee and Youth Involvement Group.




